RESULTS OF NORTHLAND DEBATE SCORECARD BALLOT

Kansas City, MO – The citizens have spoken and the results are in after Tuesday night's debate in the Northland featuring 10 candidates for mayor of Kansas City, Missouri.

The debate was sponsored by the Community Coalition to Fix Barry Road. There were 198 people in attendance at Park Hill High School Auditorium, and 110 scorecard ballots were turned in to organizers at the end of the debate.

Each scorecard ballot allowed citizens to rate the candidates with a point system between 1 (low) and 5 (high) on the following areas:

- Opening Statement
- Vision
- Integrity
- Leadership
- Communication Style
- Northland Issues
- Closing Question

There were a total of 3,850 points available based on 110 ballots submitted. The citizens' rankings and total points accumulated per candidate are as follows:
